

LOCAL RULES (to be read in conjunction with Rules of Golf and Temporary Local Rules)

1. OUT OF BOUNDS

Any area beyond the Club's perimeter is Out of Bounds. When playing the 10th hole the 17th fairway is Out of Bounds.

2. YOUNG TREES

The young trees identified by stakes are no play zones:

- If a player's ball lies anywhere on the course other than in a penalty area and it lies on or touches such a tree or such a tree interferes with the player's stance or area of intended swing, the player **MUST** take relief under Rule 16.1f.
- If the ball lies in a penalty area, and interference to the player's stance or area of intended swing exists from such a tree, the player **MUST** take relief either with penalty under Rule 17.1e or with free relief under Rule 17.1e(2).

Penalty for Playing Ball from a Wrong Place in Breach of Local Rule: General Penalty Under Rule 14.7a.

3. FIXED SPRINKLER HEADS AND HOSES

All fixed sprinkler heads and hoses are immovable obstructions and relief from interference by them may be obtained under Rule 16.1. In addition, if a fixed sprinkler head on or within two club lengths of the putting green being played intervenes on the line of play between the ball and the hole, the player may obtain relief without penalty as follows: If the ball lies off the putting green but not in a hazard and is within two club lengths of the intervening obstruction, it may be lifted, cleaned and dropped at the nearest point to where the ball lay which (a) is not nearer the hole, (b) avoids such intervention and (c) is not in a hazard or on a putting green.

4. TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE ROPES, HOOPS & SIGNS

All temporary protective ropes, poles holding ropes, hoops, flags and signs are treated as immovable obstructions & relief may be taken in accordance with Rule 16.1. If a ball strikes the Temporary Protective Ropes, the Holding Poles, the Hoops, Flags or Signs the stroke **may** be cancelled and replayed without penalty (See Rule 14.6.)

5. GARDEN BEDS

Garden Beds are defined by surrounding borders and relief may be taken under Rule 16.1.

6. WHEEL MARKS

Except in a hazard, wheel marks made by a mower, tractor or motor vehicle, are ground under repair. Rule 16.1 applies.

Note: This does not include worn bare dirt areas caused by cart use.

7. PATHS

All constructed pathways and their integral drainage are to be treated as immovable Obstructions. Rule 16.1 applies.

Note: This does not include worn bare dirt areas caused by cart use.

8. OVERHEAD POWER WIRES AND POLES

When playing the 2nd hole if overhead power wires or poles are struck the shot **MUST** be replayed.

9. STONE WASH

All stone wash from paths is to be treated as GUR and relief **may** be taken in accordance with Rule 16.1. If a ball, the player's stance or area of intended swing interferes, the player **may** lift and drop without penalty within ONE club length not nearer the hole from the nearest point of relief.

10. SUSPENSION OF PLAY

One siren blast.

11. RESUMPTION OF PLAY

Two siren blasts.

12. NOTE ALL STAKES ARE IMMOVABLE OBSTRUCTION, RULE 16.1 APPLIES

13. PEGS

WHITE = GUR (Ground Under Repair)

WHITE WITH BLACK TOP = OOB (Out of Bounds)

RED = RED PENALTY AREA

YELLOW = YELLOW PENALTY AREA

Breach of General rule in stroke play = 2 strokes & in match play loss of hole.
